Date: July 1-August 22

Price: \$275/wk.

Schedule: M-Th. 8:30am-12:30pm

Stay and Play: 12:30-2:30pm \$25/day if prearranged at the start of the week. \$30/day drop-in. A healthy snack and additional themed activities are included in Stay and Play.

Registration: A nonrefundable registration fee of \$50 before March 1, 2024 /\$100 after March 1, 2024, is due at the time of enrollment regardless of the number of weeks enrolled. Summer camp enrollment is based on availability and submission of an application does not ensure enrollment in the weeks requested. An enrollment confirmation and required registration forms will be emailed once the fee and application is received. A signed Sunnyside School House Parent Handbook agreement is also required to complete summer camp registration.

Ages: 3-5 yrs. Children that are 2 years old may enroll in summer camp if they are enrolled in our regular school year program. Children that are not potty trained will be charged an additional \$50 potty training fee to their registration fee.

Snack and Lunch: All campers are required to bring a snack and lunch from home as well as a water bottle.

All summer tuition and required registration forms are due by June 1, 2024. After June 1 all summer camp tuition is nonrefundable.
